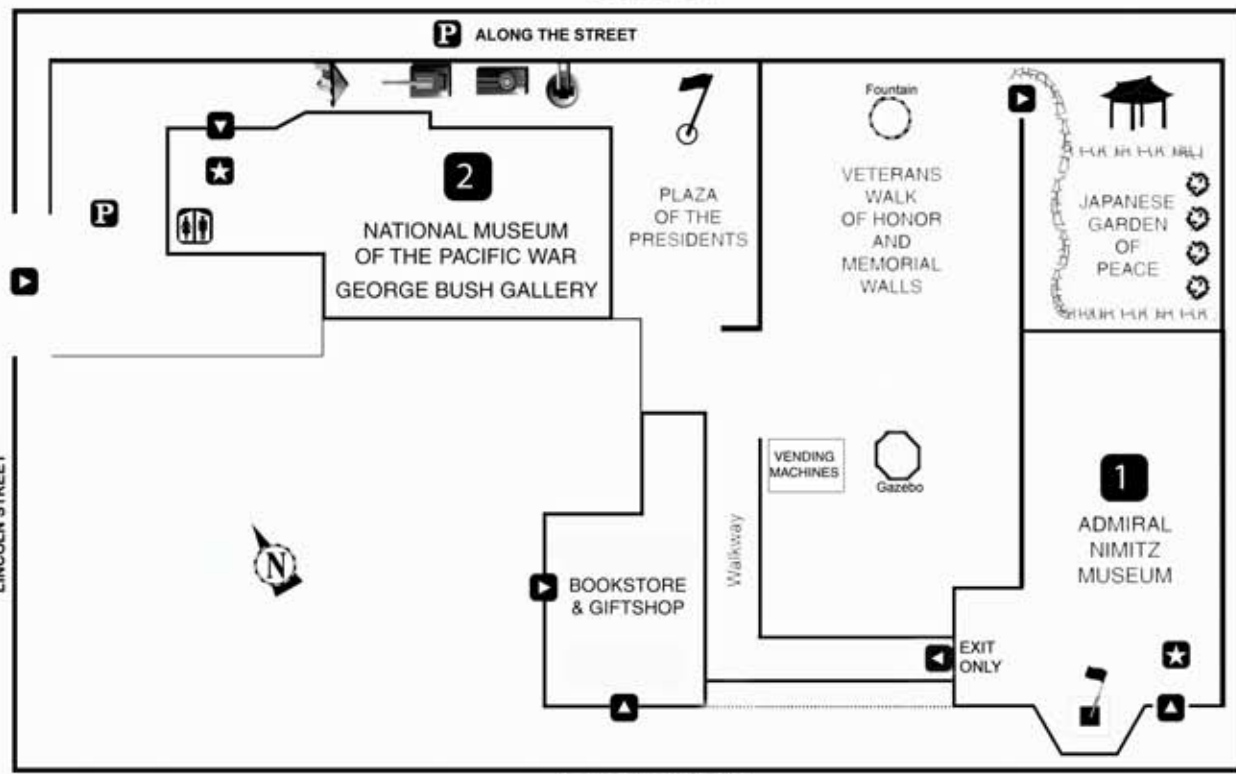

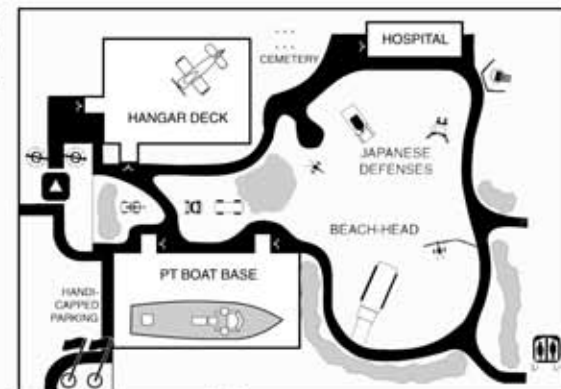

- 1** **Admiral Nimitz Museum (Self Guided)**
The cornerstone of the National Museum of the Pacific War has exhibits that focus on the life of Fleet Admiral Chester Nimitz, his family, and his connections to Fredericksburg.
- 2** **National Museum of the Pacific War -George H.W. Bush Gallery (Self Guided)**
Pacific War exhibits spanning the pre-war period through Japan's surrender.
- 3** **Pacific Combat Zone (guided tour only)**
This three acre site showcases the museum's large artifacts in their unique environments, such as:
 - Hangar deck with TBM Avenger
 - PT boat base housing PT 309
 - Invasion beach with landing craft and artillery
 - Field hospital, and much more
